From April 2017 to June 2017, HRNK was featured in a total of 52 news articles in English language media. News agencies featuring HRNK included CNN, The New York Times, Korea Times, The Christian Times, Business Insider, ABC, and The Christian Post. Here are a few highlights from the second quarter of 2017:

- On May 3, 2017, The New York Times published a Letter to the Editor from HRNK Executive Director Greg Scarlatoiu entitled "<u>Market Totalitarianism in North Korea</u>," submitted in response to a New York Times article from May 1, 2017 entitled, "<u>As Economy Grows, North Korea</u>'s <u>Grip on Society Is Tested</u>."
- On May 14, 2017, The Korea Times quoted HRNK Co-Vice Chair Suzanne Scholte in "<u>Political prisoners in North</u> <u>Korea</u>" on the need for a continuous process stressing the release of political prisoners.

- On April 27, 2017, HRNK published <u>"An Open Letter to</u> <u>President Donald Trump"</u> on <u>HRNK Insider</u>, authored by Robert Collins and George Hutchinson, arguing that President Trump's unconventional communication and problem-solving talents are needed on North Korean human rights issues. This story was subsequently picked up and relayed by <u>Chosun News</u>, <u>Yonhap News</u>, <u>News 1</u>, and <u>SBS News</u>.
- On May 2, 2017, <u>RFA</u> published an opinion piece by HRNK Executive Director Greg Scarlatoiu on North Korean labor and international labor rights.
- On May 11, 2017, HRNK Executive Director Greg Scarlatoiu was interviewed by <u>Kookmin Ilbo</u> on the relationship between the new ROK and US administrations and the upcoming summit.
